## TECHNICAL EDUCATION: SYSTEM ADMINISTRATOR CERTIFICATION



### COURSE DESCRIPTION

This instructor-led course, offered at a Panasas facility or at a customer site, delivers a complete introduction to the Panasas® ActiveStor® storage system and allows the student to earn certification as a Panasas System Administrator. Topics covered include ActiveStor hardware, the PanFS® parallel file storage operating system, and the DirectFlow® data access protocol. The course provides a System Administrator or IT team member with the knowledge to install, configure, and maintain a Panasas ActiveStor system. Each student will gain a firm understanding of configuration, operation and maintenance of the Panasas suite of products as well as obtain instructions on how to diagnose and resolve various software and hardware errors.

The redundant components of the Panasas hardware solution are discussed and reinforced with lab exercises and hands-on activities demonstrating how to service each field-replaceable unit. Object-based file-system theory, software upgrades, and configuration scenarios will be also discussed.

The instructor will focus on the fundamentals of the PanFS storage operating system, the DirectFlow client access software for Linux®, the Panasas storage virtualization model, and the PanActive® management interface (both CLI and GUI). Students will be introduced to the features available when deploying a Panasas storage system and how to best configure the system to obtain optimal redundancy and performance.

### PREREQUISITES

This course is designed for attendees who possess a basic understanding of:

- General IP Networking
- Disk RAID concepts
- Familiarity with NFS and/or file-system usage
- Experience interfacing with UNIX® and/or Linux

Students are responsible for complying with all prerequisite material. Students who demonstrate a gap in the prerequisite knowledge may be asked to limit questions during class time so as not to impede the overall progress of the class.

### CERTIFICATION

Successful completion of the Panasas System Administrator course ensures that your staff has been trained on daily system operation, configuration and maintenance of the Panasas ActiveStor storage system. Students who attend all presentations, complete all practical application exercises, and pass the final exam are awarded the *Panasas System Administrator Certificate of Completion* by Panasas Global Services.

## INSTRUCTOR-LED TRAINING

## EQUIPMENT

Panasas will provide equipment for use by students in hands-on lab exercises. In addition, students are required to bring a laptop or suitable portable device with wireless capability and an installed SSH client (such as PuTTY).

## CLASS PARTICIPATION

Attendance is the responsibility of the registrant. In order to successfully complete the course, 100% attendance is required. If a registrant fails to appear for a scheduled class, or fails to complete the entire course, the full course fee is charged and certification is not guaranteed.

## CONFIRMATION

Panasas will send you a confirmation letter upon registration. We recommend that you bring it to class to confirm class attendance eligibility.

## STUDENT CANCELLATION POLICY

Individual training registrants cancelling a scheduled class at a Panasas facility have the option to transfer their registration to a future class or receive a full refund, provided Panasas is notified of the cancellation at least 14 calendar days prior to the course start date.
